International Nurses Day 12 May

Today we acknowledge the amazing contribution our nurses have made over the past centuries.

Sister Vivian Bullwinkel of the Australian Army Nursing service was posted to hospital duty in Singapore during world War Two. In 1942, after the Japanese captured Singapore, Vivian was among 300 people evacuated from the city by boat. Despite being captured and injured, Vivian dedicated herself as a leader in nursing and humanitarian after the war.

Lucy Osburn (1836 – 1891)

Lucy Osburn is described by many as the founder of nursing in Australia. In 1868 she was sent to found Nightingale Nursing. Lucy was a superintendent of the Sydney Infirmary and dispensary and was considered to be highly practical and campaigned to introduce nursing training to Australia.
